Throughout the Center's sixty year history, it has supported artists and their art. The Community Arts Center's Fine Arts and Crafts Festival is the natural progression of this mission.

THE FINE ARTS and CRAFTS FESTIVAL

In its seventh year, the Community Arts Center will host a two-day festival and sale of fine art and craft presented by the area's finest artisans at ROSE TREE PARK in Media, PA.

ROSE TREE PARK, located on Route 252 (Providence Road) in Media, Pennsylvania is an ideal location for an arts festival. The beautiful grounds, easily accessible location and ample convenient parking will attract many visitors to this unique and well respected annual event. **This is a well attended event with visitors coming from throughout the Delaware Valley.**

The Arts Center is committed to presenting the finest work created by the many talented artists throughout the northeast. This year, participation in this festival is limited to no more than one hundred (100) artists. The Rose Tree Park setting is the perfect place for fine artists to offer their original work to discriminating art buyers and collectors.

PLEASE NOTE

Accepted artists will be asked to submit one piece for inclusion in a raffle to be held at the FESTIVAL. Proceeds of this raffle will support the COMMUNITY ARTS CENTER. Artists contributing to the raffle will receive IN-KIND donation receipts from the Community Arts Center, as well as our deep thanks and appreciation!



REQUIREMENTS:

Work will be accepted in the following categories: Drawing and Pastels, Graphics and Printmaking, Oil and Acrylic, Watercolor, Mixed Media, Ceramics, Glass, Sculpture, Fibers, Wood, Jewelry and Metal, Photography

The artist must be present for the entire festival and will be responsible for the sale of her/his work. No agents, dealers or merchants are permitted.

All work exhibited must be created by the entrant. Absolutely no prints (including notecards, calendars or other small reproductions), other than hand-pulled art prints (serigraphs, etchings, etc. printed by the artist) will be accepted. No mechanically reproduced prints will be accepted. No giclee prints will be accepted.

Each work exhibited must be clearly labeled with the price. There are no commissions charged by the Community Arts Center on any sales.

Unacceptable items include: imported work of any type, work created by a person other than the artist, greenware pottery, sculpture from molds, handicrafts, mass produced factory art, reproductions on notecards or postcards as well as any other items deemed by the committee to not fall within the spirit of our requirements. Selected artists may NOT display OR sell these items at the Community Arts Center's Fine Arts and Crafts Festival.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Applicants may submit the following for consideration of the jury:

- four (4) 35 mm. slides of their work and one (1) slide or photo of their display. Slides must be 2" X 2" cardboard or plastic mount in a plastic sleeve. Please print your name and medium on each slide. (Place a red dot in the lower left hand corner of the front of each slide.) Each slide/photo must be numbered to correspond with the descriptions on the application form. Artists may attach a detailed description of their work to the entry form.

OR

-a CD with digital files for viewing in jpg format at a minimum of 72 dpi saved to highest level, with the longest dimension being 900 pixels. Please label each file with last name, first initial, and number corresponding to the entry number on your form. (e.g. SmithJ1) If digital files are submitted, please identify images on the entry form with the title of the work.

Applicants MUST include a self-addressed, stamped envelope with their application for the return of slides and the jury's decision. No slides of work will be returned without a SASE. No CD's will be returned.

Exhibitors will be permitted to exhibit only the specific type of work submitted. If entering in more than one category, please submit separate applications. As an example, jewelry cannot be exhibited with another medium unless approved by the jury.

A non-refundable jury fee of \$25 is required and must be submitted with the properly completed application and the required slides/photos. In addition, applicants should include a check for space rental (\$125 for CAC members/ \$145 for non-members).

Selected exhibitors will be assigned a 10' X 10' space on the grounds at Rose Tree Park. Each exhibitor must bring everything needed for display.

The Community Arts Center will return the booth fee checks and slides of any applicant NOT accepted to exhibit in the festival, provided a SASE is included with the entry form. Materials of selected exhibitors will be returned the day of the festival. A maximum of one hundred (100) exhibitors will be selected with a balance of media to be represented.

Each selected exhibitor will receive festival invitations to distribute.

Completed applications must be received by the Community Arts Center no later than June 15, 2009. Artists will be notified of the jury's decision by July 6, 2009. If an exhibitor must cancel, 50% of the exhibition fee will be refunded prior to September 1, 2009. There will be no refunds for cancellations after September 1,
